At the beginning of the meeting, the chairperson welcomed the participants and delivered a brief introduction about the Bangabandhu Sheikh Mujib Shilpa Nagar (BSMSN) Development Project (Bangladesh PRIDE Project). The chairperson has then highlighted the objectives of the Pre-Bid meeting and delivered a short presentation on different issues of this package and Bid Document specifically the Two-envelope with rated criteria Bidding process to get convenient the Bidders for preparation of the Bid. The chairperson has discussed then the background of the package and the major areas of the Bid Document.

The chairperson explained the Instructions to Bidders (ITB), Bid Data Sheet (BDS), Evaluation and Qualification Criteria, Bidding Forms, Works Requirements, General Conditions, Particular Conditions and Contract forms etc. He then highlighted important content of the Bid Document specifically ITB Clause 11 regarding document comprising the Bid, ITB Clause 17 regarding the documents establishing the eligibility and qualifications of the Bidder and ITB Clause 21-24 for submission requirements of Bid. According to ITB Clause 11.4 the Technical Part shall not include any information related to the Bid price. Where material financial information related to the Bid price is contained in the Technical Part the Bid shall be declared non-responsive.

Subsequently, the chairperson advised all prospective Bidders to visit and examine the site and carry out necessary survey and investigations prior submitting the Bid for better understanding and for the accuracy of purpose. If the Bidder wishes to take any assistance, necessary arrangements will be provided by the employer's field staff including showing the scheme site.

Bidders' findings regarding different information on the proposed site may be reflected in their technical proposal. He requested the participants to prepare the Bid following terms and conditions set forth in the Bid Document, and carefully filled up all necessary forms for a complete submission of Bid.

The Chairperson then invited questions/queries from the participating Bidders and/or their representatives. Their queries along with the explanations/clarifications have been discussed as given below:






